We are delighted to welcome you to the 40th anniversary event of the Eastleigh 10k. The first race was held on 17 March 1985 at 2.30pm.



By Rail

Eastleigh is on the main London to Weymouth line and is connected to Portsmouth and Southampton. Eastleigh station is 1 mile from the start.

By Bus

Regular bus services run between Southampton, Winchester and Eastleigh. The bus station is 1 mile from the start. There is a regular bus service from the town centre to Places Leisure Eastleigh.


By Road

Please car share where possible. Parking is limited please arrive early. Eastleigh Town is well served by the M3 (Jct 13) to the north, and the M27 (Jct 5) to the East and West. There are limited car parking spaces indicated "P" on the map. Where street parking is used, please park with consideration for local residents. Runners should arrive no later than 8:15am. After this, local road closures will be in place.

Instructions to Athletes

- Car parking is very limited at Places
 Leisure Eastleigh. Please ensure you
 arrive in good time. Parking is available
 in local roads, but allow extra time to
 walk to the leisure centre.
- Chip timing is on the back of your number. Keep your number flat and do not put safety pins through the chip.
- Runners taking 45 minutes or more to reach 5km (Leigh Rd lights) will be required to observe normal changes in traffic signals, and use the pavement where appropriate.
- No race numbers may be exchanged after 12noon on Sunday 16 March 2025.
 An email to director@runningmania.co.uk must be received by this time.
- Competitors must wear the official race number at the front.
- Water and refreshments at 6km and at the finish.
- Loss of race number or chip should be reported to an official at the finish line.
- Runners must keep to the left except on Chestnut Avenue.
- Runners must obey the instruction of Marshals at all times.
- Any medical condition should be declared on the reverse of your race number.
- Runners can wear bone conducting headphones during the race.
- Toilets and changing are available within the leisure centre, and at Pavillion on the Park.

 Results will be available online at www.runningmania.co.uk later on race day.



Prizes Awarded

Only the Men's and Women's senior prizes will be awarded on the day. Veteran and team prizes will be sent via email or can be collected from Up & Running once results have been confirmed.

Men: First 5 individuals plus first 3 teams (3 to score).

Veteran Men: 1st and 2nd places. Prizes in 5 year age categories from 40+ to 70+.1st Team (first 3 veteran men to score).

Women: First 5 individuals plus first 3 teams (3 to score).

Veteran Women: 1st and 2nd places. Prizes in 5 year age categories from 35+ to 65+. 1st Team (first 3 veteran women to score).

Boys/Girls: 15-16 yrs - 1st
